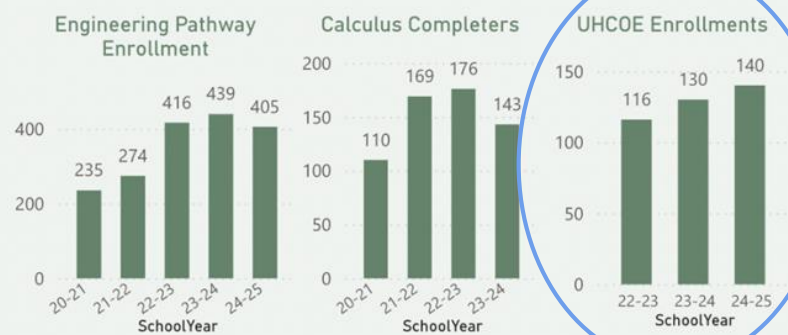

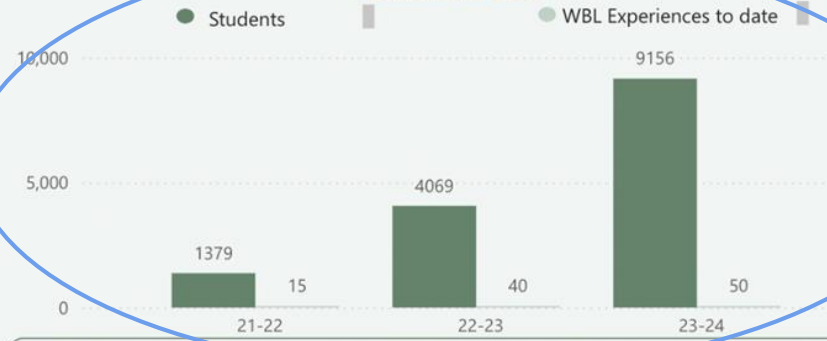

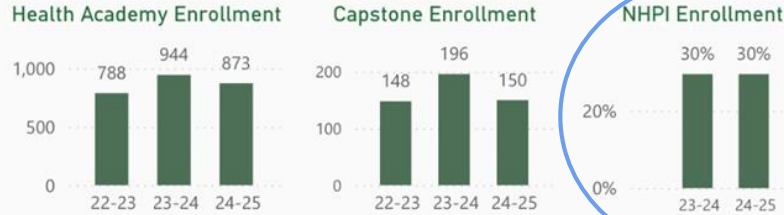

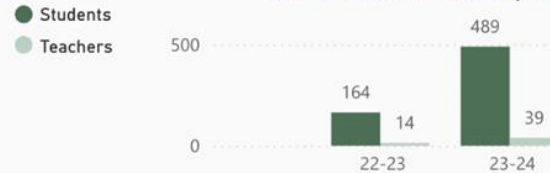

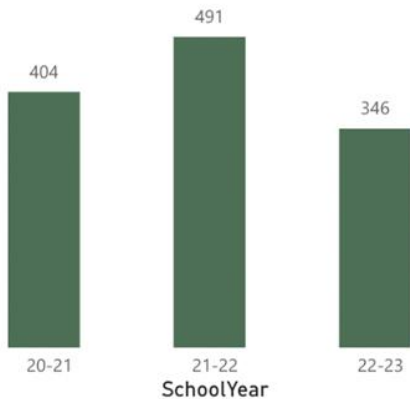

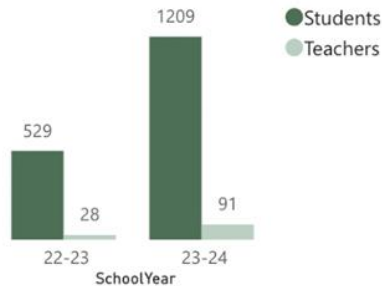
## HIDOE Indicators
